Should only be the polygons of the current entity differentiate between the two types or also the ones that are not selected (other entities, sibling, parents and children, which are currently coloured differently)? This would result in a lot of different colours.

Therefore I would suggest that we do not change the colour but the border thickness. Meaning shape polygons will have a border as it is right now and area polygons will have no borders.

Perfect thank you! I'm quite nerve wrecking, I know, but is it possible to make the border a bit bigger. I think stroke-width of 2 would make a big visual impact.
