When you go to the tab Events, you will see the events but without the dates. The same events work fine in places, so the problem must be in the Actor Eventtable.

At places the event dates are shown because there are no other dates. Unlike actors, places are thought to be (for the sake of simplicity) there for the whole event ;)

Thanks for reporting anyway, it could have been a bug.
